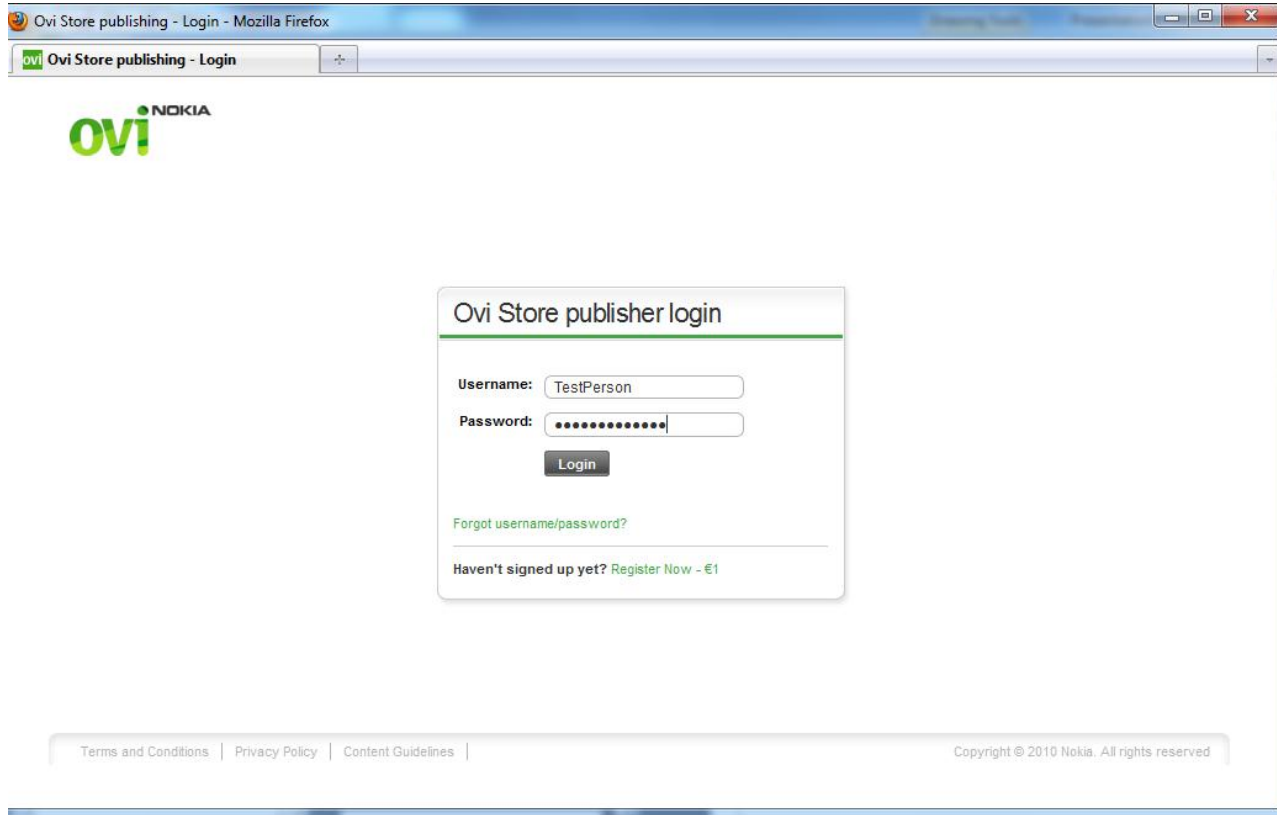

Note: Applications requiring any of the following capabilities still need to be certified through Symbian Signed: MultimediaDD, NetworkControl, CommDD, DiskAdmin, AllFiles, DRM or TCB
